

Line Dance Extra Credit

This is a group extra credit assignment. You will need between 5-10 students to earn the credit for this assignment. I really want this to be a fun experience for you and your group.

Although there are several line dances we will be learning in class, there are hundreds of them that we are not going to learn...we just don't have the time. Many of the line dances out there use different music, beats, and footwork...in other words, the world of line dance is endless.

Your assignment:

1. Use some type of video resource page to view different type of line dances that we DID NOT DO in class. The best video resource page is Youtube, however, there are several other sites on the Internet as well. In fact, there is a great, energetic and fun dance on the 6th Grade Line Dance page at the bottom by Alan Jackson. Feel free to do that dance.
2. After watching several dances, choose the dance that your group likes the most or your group thinks will be the easiest (and most exciting) to perform.
3. In your small group, using the same steps in the video, choreograph and perform the line dance. You can either use the song that was used in the video or your own song, as long as the rhythm and beat is an identical pattern.
4. Schedule time with me to perform at lunch or brunch.
5. Submit a half page paper covering the following information (only one sheet of paper needs to be turned in for the entire group):
 - a. Name, Period, and Roll Calls of every group member
 - b. Why did you choose that particular dance?
 - c. Where did you find the dance? (site the exact source name- in other words, I need the entire URL of where you found the dance)
 - d. What did you enjoy the most about doing this group project.
